Summary:	Stormwater management is a critical function of the City, which is administered by the Public Works Department. The proper functioning of the stormwater system and completion of capital improvements ensures the City's ability to minimize flooding. These measures also meet the water quality requirements of state and federal agencies. This workshop will present an overview of stormwater to the City Commission, including the City's policies related to stormwater management and the actions taken to meet City goals.

Citizen Impact:	The management of storm water runoff has a direct impact on the quality of life for City residents. Successful management of these water resources is critical to prevent flooding and provide for water quality treatment of rainfall runoff.
