Summary

FDOT has requested to present information related to the proposed improvements to be made to Nova Road.

FDOT will be resurfacing 4 miles of Nova Road and add safety improvements, including a raised median, new turn lanes, a new signal at Old Kings Road, a directional median at Arroyo Parkway, upgraded signals and lighting, and ADA-compliant curb ramps.

This will be FDOT's opportunity to update the City Commission on this project and obtain feedback.



Nova Road (S.R. 5A) From Flomich Street to U.S. 1

Volusia County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning to resurface approximately four miles of Nova Road (State Road (S.R.) 5A) from Flomich Street to U.S. 1 in the cities of Holly Hill and Ormond Beach.

The project also proposes to replace the existing center two-way left-turn lane on Nova Road between Granada Boulevard (S.R. 40) and Wilmette Avenue with a raised median to enhance safety and operations. Dedicated left-turn lanes and median openings will be provided to accommodate access along the corridor. Additionally, a new traffic signal with pedestrian crossings will also be constructed at Old Kings Road.

Through continued coordination with local partners, the design will maintain the existing three travel lanes in each direction on Nova Road between Granada Boulevard and Wilmette Avenue.

Farther south, a new directional median will be constructed at Arroyo Parkway to reduce the chances of severe left-turn and angle crashes. The median will allow left turns from Nova Road to Arroyo Parkway. However, traffic turning onto Nova Road from Arroyo Parkway will be restricted to right turns only.



Other improvements proposed along the corridor include upgrading traffic and pedestrian signals, enhancing lighting at all signalized intersections, and reconstructing pedestrian curb ramps as needed to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Standards.
